

Spring Mountain Christian Academy Quick Facts

1. Early registration starts February 1st (for existing students).
2. Tuition can be paid in 12 months, 6 months, semester or annual payment.
3. All payments are made as electronic withdrawals from checking account.
4. School hours: 8:10 am-3:30 pm (Grades K-5) & 8:20-3:45 pm (Grades 6-12).
5. School days – Monday – Thursday.
6. Occasional Friday school is built into the calendar (snow days, academic support days).
7. Hot lunch program is available at elementary campus only.
8. Middle school 6-8 bring lunch to school. They are not allowed to leave the school's property. High school (9-12) are allowed to leave the school's property during lunch.
9. General dress code: tops-solid approved colors for tops, no short skirts, no open tops, no flip flops. PE clothes on PE days. See the dress code file for more details.
10. There is some homework almost every day (we are a 4-day school).
11. AP classes, dual credit college classes with CCC and George Fox, PSAT, SAT, AP tests.
12. Kindergarten classes (K4 & K5) have a snack schedule.
13. Athletic seasons are by need and demand. Students do have PE twice a week, grades 7-12 have access to a professional gym and work with fitness instructors.
14. Failure to stay current in tuition payments results in student withdrawal. Withdrawal fees apply.
15. Students serve detention for violating school rules (detention may be scheduled before school, after school, or during school).
16. Parents serve volunteer/service hours in the school. 30 per family, 40 if fin. aid is awarded, 15 if single parent household.
17. All fees are due at registration.
18. Immunizations: required during registration or sign waver by completing the tutorial online.
19. Frequent communication with parents: Email and text messaging.
20. State testing: twice a year. Fall and Spring. MAPS Growth (NWEA).
21. Students participate in school competitions, academic and team building trips and retreats. All students are expected to participate.
22. Most grades have a waitlist.
23. Parents are responsible for transporting their students to school. Carpool is strongly encouraged.

27. We use renweb/FACTS Management system and google classroom.
28. Computer literacy classes and technology is provided to every student.
29. Frequent field trips. Parents often help with transportation and organization.

31. College & career planning classes. Job shadow and internship opportunities. FAFSA application.
32. We are a cell phone free school (phones, smart watches, other electronic devices must be on mute and out of sight). Please see office for more detailed policy and consequences.
